A Plein Air painting event is scheduled for Historic Spring City, Utah. Spring City is located in Sanpete County, a scenic, pastoral rural landscape, this county of is dotted with sheep, cattle, horse and agricultural farms as well as historic cities, and is known for its beautiful countryside of farmlands, majestic mountains and wonderful blue skies.
