Rules Agreement

This event is open to any artist who paints using plein air techniques, in all fine art painting mediums (oils, acrylics, gouaches, watercolors, pastels or pencils). Other mediums may be accepted upon previous approval at registration. Artists must paint on location within Sanpete County during the official painting period of August 27-29, 2014. No use of photography, photographs, photographic or computer equipment is allowed for painting plein air competition entries.

All art must be created in the field (no studio work), and all surfaces (canvas/board/paper) must be date stamped and authenticated at our Spring City gallery prior to painting. Artists may pre-register by mail or can register in Spring City during any of the registration dates and times. The flexible registration periods allow artists to spend 1 to 3 days painting. Artists may submit 1 to 5 paintings for the competition.

All completed artwork to be entered in the competition show must be framed and/or in a condition to be traditionally hung in an art show/competition. Preferably, this would be a hanging wire installed on the reverse side of the entered framed artwork. Artists assume all risk and liability for any artwork hung in and during the show. All plein air entries must be returned by the scheduled deadline or earlier. Artists must assign a selling price for all their artwork, considering Spring City Arts (SCA) will receive a 35% commission from the assigned price. Artists are responsible to pick up all artwork after the Plein Air Sale, which ends on Saturday at 6:00 pm.

Artists are responsible for their own transportation, lodging and painting supplies. Painting supplies are not available locally, so come prepared. Local dining choices are limited, but we will provide a hospitality center, offering free snacks for the artists each day, and lunch on Thursday. There will also be a pot-luck dinner Thursday evening, and a reception for the Artists Friday evening, with food. Saturday evening, the artists are invited to stay around to enjoy a live performance of the "Life Under the Horseshoe" Radio show and an old fashioned Barn Dance.

If you are missing something you need in order to paint or frame your artwork, we may be able to assist you at our hospitality center.

Spring City Arts, its sponsors, staff and volunteers, will not be responsible for any theft, loss, incident, accident or legal situations to the artist, artwork and/or personal property before, during or after the competition. Artists are responsible for providing any or all insurance or to cover themselves, their artwork and/or their property. SCA will not be responsible for any artwork left, not picked-up or arranged for pick-up or delivery by the artist. Artists are responsible to ask and receive permission to paint private property where needed and/or trespass on private property.

Artists, by participating in this competition, agree to follow these rules, behave as professional artists, and conform to public and artistic ethics during the competition. Judges will have final discretion with respect to awards. SCA reserves the right to adjudicate any work shown in the competition and sale. Participating artists will allow SCA to photograph all paintings and release to SCA such images and work for promotional and publicity purposes.

I am entering this event and painting at my own risk. SCA will not be responsible for any accidents, personal injury, loss or damage which occurs during this event. SCA, the artists, staff, volunteers and sponsors of this event are not liable for any accident or injury. I have read and accept the above rules and conditions for the art competition and sale.
